SAILING INSTRUCTIONS – amended 9/02/2010

START

Start time will be approx 18:00H

Starting sequence is as below

17:55	Warning signal	3 white lights ON
17:56	Preparatory signal	2 white lights ON
17:59	One minute warning	1 white light ON
18:00	Start	All lights OFF

Starting lights are located on the front of the SBSC Tower

Start /Finish will be between the SBSC Tower Flag Pole and 5knot marker located directly in front of the SBSC Clubhouse

COURSES

Course 1:

NO Flags hoisted on flag pole in SBSC boat yard

All Marks to PORT

- Start to Reef Mark off Martha Point
Approx. Position
38° 17.47' S
144° 58.46' E
- Mussel Farm – Leave all clearance marks to Port
- Finish

Course 2:

AUSTRALIAN Flag will be hoisted on flag pole in SBSC boat yard

All Marks to PORT

- Start to Reef Mark off Martha Point
Approx. Position
38° 17.47' S
144° 58.46' E
- R1 (Recreation Buoy #1)
Approx. Position
38° 16.40' S
144° 58.40' E
- Mussel Farm – Leave all clearance marks to Port
- Finish

NOTES

1. White sails ONLY – no spinnakers allowed
2. Finish cut off time will be sun down
Any yachts finishing after this time will be recorded as DNF
3. Please advise (by return email) any current handicaps i.e. PHS, CBH, AMS
4. Radio communication will be on VHF Channel 69
5. Constructive feedback welcome
